HOW TO MEDICATE YOUR DOG



If your veterinarian prescribes oral medication for your dog, these tips may help:

- 1. When giving your dog tablets, it is easiest to hide the pill in a small amount of the canned Hill's® Prescription Diet® food you are feeding your pet or in a small piece of cheese. (See Figure 1)
- 2. If you offer this as a treat before the regular meal, your dog should willingly accept it.
- 3. To give your dog a liquid medication, insert the dropper between the teeth and cheek, far enough so the medication doesn't dribble out of the dog's mouth. While tilting the chin upward, slowly dispense the medication. (See Figure 2)
